Dear Exhibitors loving the history of the “Mediterranean Week” of the Principality of Monaco, Italy & France.

Following the meeting held in Monaco on September 23, 2015 between the partners taking part in the event, it was decided to change the name "Mediterranean Week" to "Mediterranean Trophy".

The actualization consists in making compete with the dogs which obtained in the same year the three CACIB envisaged, a Best in Show between them. The dog decreed the best will become the winner of the Final Grand Trophy and will win from the three Organizing Committees the free registration of this same dog for the competition in the Mediterranean "Trophy" competition the following year.

The rule change will come into effect on January 1, 2016.

REGULATIONS OF THE MEDITERRANEAN TROPHY

1. The Trophy and the diploma of winners of the TDM will be assigned within the framework of the Exhibition which closes the circuit to the dogs which have obtained during the year of the competition three CACIB in these three different countries and by three different judges: Principality of Monaco - Italy - France. The original CACIB cards must be presented to the secretariat of the Organizing Committee to start the procedures.

2. The Trophy is intended for both males and females.

3. Once the winners have been established, within the framework of the Show which closes the circuit, all the qualified dogs (those also of the same breed but of different sex) will parade on the Ring of Honor where a Judge will choose the best subject between all competitors or “Best of Trophy”.

The Trophy assigned will be a "Challenger" on which the name of the winner, the title and the year will be affixed at each Competition. The winner will be able to take a lap of honor and be photographed with the Trophy but in no case will be able to leave with it. He must return the Trophy to the Organizing Committee when he leaves.

A replica of the Trophy will be given as a souvenir in return to the holder of the "Challenger" for the relative year when the latter is returned.

The last Organizing Committee will give the "Challenger" to whoever will open the competition the following year, so that it can be displayed on the Ring of Honor of the three Committees.
